### Planning Your Visit

The International Museum of Radiant Peace is free and is open to the public between September 13 and December 20 on all Saturdays from 10-4 and almost every day by appointment: call 727-343-8212 to schedule your visit. As one child said about us, we are a small place with a lot of stuff! We can accommodate groups of up to 15 adults, or 15 children accompanied by teachers or staff. Museum tours include activities geared to the interests and ages of the visitors: ask about specific areas of interest when you schedule your visit. Plan approximately one hour for your visit. Please note that there are no vending machines or eating areas in the museum.

### Getting Here



The International Museum of Radiant Peace is at **5601 Central Avenue, St. Petersburg** (on the corner of 56<sup>th</sup> Street and Central Avenue, diagonally across from the Kopper Kitchen Restaurant). City busses run regularly on Central Avenue. The Museum is the two-story building with the purple awning facing Central Avenue. The Museum parking lot is big enough for a school bus, and there is additional free on-street parking along 56<sup>th</sup> Street.

**From I-275 Southbound:** Take the 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue N. exit. Go straight through the traffic light at the bottom of the exit ramp. You will be on 20<sup>th</sup> Street N. Continue to the next light and turn RIGHT onto 1st Avenue N. Go to 56<sup>th</sup> Street N. and turn LEFT. The museum building and parking lot are on the right.

**From I-275 Northbound:** Take Exit #18 (26<sup>th</sup> Avenue S.). Turn LEFT onto 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue S. At the next light, turn RIGHT onto 34<sup>th</sup> Street S. Go 25 blocks and turn LEFT onto Central Avenue. Go to 56<sup>th</sup> Street N. and turn RIGHT. The museum building is on the left.
